

WINTER WEATHER UPDATE

Monday, February 23rd, 2026

Due to the dangerous and potentially historic winter storm forecasted to impact the Tri-State area, our New Jersey terminals will be closed on Monday, February 23rd for the safety of our employees, drivers, and customers.

The National Weather Service has issued blizzard and winter storm warnings for New York City and the surrounding Tri-State region. The storm is expected to bring blizzard conditions, heavy snowfall, damaging winds, significantly reduced visibility, and possible coastal flooding. Travel conditions are anticipated to deteriorate rapidly throughout the day and overnight, making operations unsafe.

As safety remains our top priority, all terminal operations, including receiving and deliveries, will be suspended during the closure period. We will continue to monitor weather developments closely and will provide updates regarding reopening as soon as conditions safely permit.

We appreciate your understanding and recommend that all transportation providers and customers exercise extreme caution during this severe weather event.
